As a member of World Heritage Alliance, Maroma is committed to:

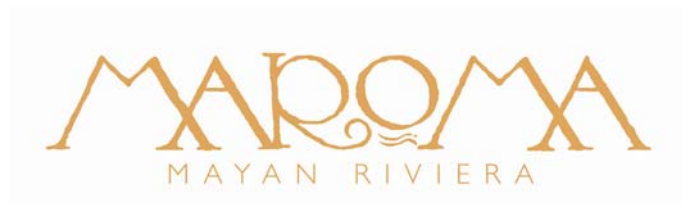
- Adhering to the World Heritage Alliance principles to promote environmental, cultural and social responsibility
